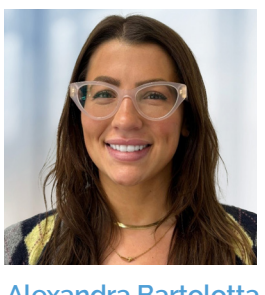
REAL LIFE MATH

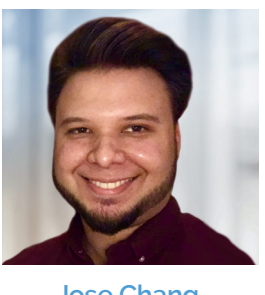
FINANCE FOR TEENS
